Széchenyi Thermal Bath and Swimming Pool Supplementary House Rules

The current house rules of the Budapest Spas cPlc apply in the Széchenyi Thermal Bath and Swimming Pool, with the additions listed below:

1. Access to the saunas takes place within the opening hours of the spa by purchasing an entrance ticket, which is loaded onto the proxy watch. The ticket is only valid for the day of purchase.
2. In consideration of the special manners and customs of naturist sauna guests, offensive, sexually provocative behavior is strictly and emphatically prohibited. It is forbidden to photograph or film others, including taking photos with cell phones. It is forbidden to keep and use devices that can take photos and videos (camera, camcorder, cell phone, iPod, tablet, laptop, etc.) in the naturist sauna and at the reception.
3. Use of the saunas and the steam room is exclusively at your own risk.
4. The use of saunas and steam rooms is forbidden for children under the age of 14. Children over the age of 14 may use the saunas and steam room under the constant supervision and responsibility of a parent or adult.
5. The wearing of slippers or other footwear is prohibited in the saunas. Please note that the floors in the saunas can be very wet and you must therefore be particularly careful.
6. Participation in the sauna programs is only permitted in sauna clothing, in the dry textiles provided by the thermal spa or in your own textiles (sheet or towel) and with your body covered. In the saunas, a dry sheet or towel must be placed under the entire surface of the body to avoid contact with the sauna benches.
7. When occupying the sauna benches, make sure that you leave space for everyone (do not lie down) and maintain an appropriate distance so that sweating skin does not touch each other.
8. Make sure you cover your body, do not expose yourself and position your lower limbs so that they do not disturb others.
9. Sauna guests are not permitted to pour liquids, chemicals, sauna oils or essential oils onto the heater or to splash themselves with sauna oil in the sauna area. The sauna master holds sauna programs at the times specified in the schedule, for which tickets can be purchased at the cash desks. The times of the sauna programs are displayed together with the programs and the name of the sauna master in a visible place near the cash desks and next to the saunas. The collection for the program takes place in the relaxation area in front of the sauna participating in the program. The ticket purchased for the sauna program must be handed to the sauna master before entering the sauna, who may refuse entry to the guest without this ticket.
10. Sauna guests who have not purchased an entrance ticket for the sauna program must leave the sauna at the request of the sauna master when the sauna program is due to begin. A sauna is available in which guests can continue to sauna during the sauna program. If you would like to scent the steam room and sauna, you can contact the sauna master, who will place the scent professionally on the heater.

11. Showering is compulsory before using the plunge pool; it is forbidden to plunge into the cold pool with a sweaty, heated body, as this can cause serious damage to your health.
12. Prohibited:
 - bringing fragile objects (glass, cup, etc.), plastic or other objects that could cause accidents or injuries into the saunas and steam room,
 - disturbing the peace and quiet of sauna visitors in any way,
 - eating and drinking alcohol in the saunas and steam room,
 - wearing jewelry and glasses as they can cause burns.
13. Please report any unusual incidents (personal injury, dangerous equipment or objects) to the staff immediately.
14. Please note that the thermal spa may suspend the operation of the saunas and steam room or part thereof due to guest traffic, technical faults or operating errors. The thermal spa is therefore not obliged to compensate for any damage.
15. The sauna facilities must be vacated 20 minutes before the thermal spa closes and guests must leave the thermal spa no later than the closing time in accordance with the applicable opening times.
